
CEIAG; Measuring the Impact of Good Career Guidance.

Research shows that good career guidance has a long-term positive impact on students and pupils. This impact pathway is set out below.

Benefits can also be seen in the shorter term when pupils are still at school. These benefits include better motivation of pupils once they have clear goals for future study and careers, leading to: – higher self-esteem – higher attainment – reduced drop-out rates.

- Employer feedback on pupils' performance
- Post-16 provider feedback on applications
- Report into the Termly governor's report and committee meetings
- C&S Student Survey what we will do with this data
- Career related student drop in sessions etc
